

The analysis and development of key leadership characteristics play a vital role in uniting our team towards driving sustainable improvement—an essential attribute of any leading international school.


Kotter's renowned eight-step approach to successful leadership has garnered universal recognition across sectors, from business to education. Through this structured study, will:

This endeavour represents more than just professional development; it demonstrates our commitment to fostering a culture of continuous improvement and excellence.


By investing time in understanding and interpreting these proven leadership principles, we aim to enhance our capacity to guide DBS towards even greater heights of educational achievement.



Psychology Workshop (WC 29th Sept)

On Monday, our AS/A Level Psychology students had the privilege of attending an after school Psychology exam skills workshop. This was led by Martyn Stewart, a highly regarded psychology curriculum expert and chartered psychologist. During the workshop, students explored essential skills such as exam technique and question analysis, and received valuable insights from the feedback on the Summer 2024 exams. The workshop was an invaluable opportunity for our students to refine their exam strategies and boost their confidence ahead of their exams.



STEM Mania (WC 20th October)

STEM stands for 'Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics'. It is a concept of learning which combines all four subjects into one. STEM learning teaches children the importance of keeping an open-minded and curious approach, while also understanding how to research and evaluate information. Children are encouraged to ask questions to gain a better understanding of something and develop a growth mindset. In the STEM Mania ECA students are going through a process of using a range of skills to create model aeroplanes. Throughout the process they develop their analytical and team work skills while also gaining an understanding of aerodynamics and how we can make an object fly.


