Year 3: We are learning what makes music sound heroic or villainous.

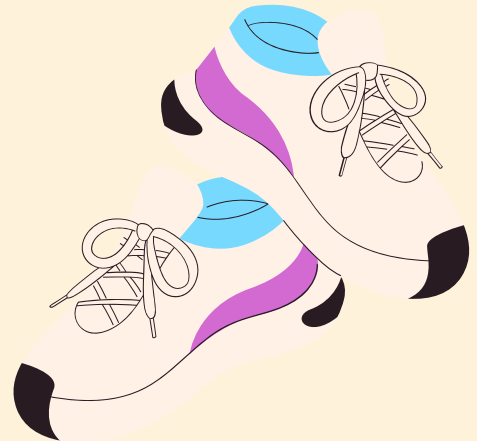
Year 4: We are demonstrating our knowledge of Vivaldi and The Four Seasons.
