
Dear Parents,

ENGLISH:

Preschool: We will be reading 'How Do Dinosuars Go to School' as we continue to settle in and establish classroom rules and boundaries.

Reception: We will be using 'Bagpuss' to help us learn new vocabulary and using our imaginations to come up with ideas of what to draw and write.

Year 1: We will be reading 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' and use our imagination to make our own descriptive drawings in Drawing Club.

Year 2: We will be writing a narrative based on Alan's Big, Scary Teeth!

Year 3: We will be writing a setting description and focusing on a range of sentence structures.

Year 4: We will be writing character and setting descriptions and focusing on expanded noun phrases.

<u>Year 5:</u> Children will be building descriptions for settings using figurative language.

Year 6: We will be writing a short burst persuasive letter.

MATHS:

Preschool: We will be sorting colours.

Reception: We will be acting out counting songs to explore changes to numbers.

Year 1: We will be revisiting and revising our subitising skills up to 10.

Year 2: We will be looking at Place value and recapping number bonds to 10 and 20.

Year 3: We will be representing and partitioning numbers to 1000 using a range of resources.

Year 4: We will be looking at Place Value and representing and ordering numbers to 1000.

Year 5: Children will be representing, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1 000 000.

Year 6: We will compare and order numbers up to 10 million.

Year 2: We are performing songs using body percussion.


Year 3: We are learning rhythmic notation.
