

# **Registration and School Timings**

Students should make their way to their tutor bases at 6:55 am so that they can be registered.



Parents or guardians of solely Secondary pupils should drop off and pick up children at the school gate. Secondary students should come into school independently of any accompanying adult.

• Students will be allowed to enter the school facilities from 6:45 am. Once in the school, students should wait until 6:55 am in the main shaded areas outside.






### **Arriving Late**

For health and safety reasons, we must be aware of who is on campus at all times.

- If a Secondary student arrives between 7:05 -7.15 am they must go to their tutor base and register with their form tutor. If they arrive to their tutor room after 7.05 am they will be marked as a late arrival.
- If a student arrives after 7.15 am they must go straight to reception to sign in late. They will receive a late card which they must show to the teacher of their first lesson.
- Students arriving late to assembly must ensure that they register with their tutor before being seated.
- Students who arrive at school after 7:05 a.m. will receive a C1 (please refer to the behaviour management section) to be completed on the same day as the tardiness.
- Any student that arrives at school after 7.05 am, will be issued with a 10-minute detention to be completed on the day of the lateness.

# **Uniforms**

### Dear Parents,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you about a recent update from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MoEHE) that will affect the school uniform requirements for all private schools starting in the new academic year on 1st September 2024. The changes are minimal for students at Doha British School (DBS), but it is important that all parents and students are aware of and prepared for these adjustments.

- Upper Body: Girls can add a second layered skin or opt for a longersleeved shirt to cover their arms. They may also continue wearing the long-sleeved jumper, fleece, or blazer, as prescribed in the DBS Uniform.
- Lower Body: Girls must wear tights or long socks with their skirts, or they can choose to wear trousers instead. Girls in secondary who choose to wear trousers need to have the shirt untucked per the image below and attached.

In addition to these changes, the PE uniform for girls from Year 4 in primary school and above has been updated to include:

- Upper Body: Girls need to wear a long-sleeved top or a long-sleeved second layer to be worn under the PE top.
- Lower Body: DBS School PE shorts + Dark colored Leggings or DBS jogging pants to be worn by girls.

For swimwear, all students are required to wear short-sleeved (to the elbow) or longer tops, along with bottoms that reach at or below the knee. This can be purchased from Zak.

Specifications of the school uniform of the students:

Year 7 and above	Year 7 and above
Trousers	Long trousers, apron, skirt, which is not higher than the knee along with Hellahop, which is not an opaque, when wearing the skirt or skirt reaching the ankle and there is need for the Hellahop with it.

		From year 7 and above Wide sports trousers or shorts, which is not higher than the knee, along with sports tights.
Swimming	All students are required to wear short- sleeved (to the elbow) or longer tops, along	
clothing	with bottoms that reach at below the knee.	

#### Notes:

- When the students participate in the sports and international competitions, the option of adherence to specifications of the sports clothing shall be left in accordance with requirements of the competition and regulator, provided that the guardian agrees to the same (this clause is applicable to all the educational stages).
- The aforementioned option shall be granted to the students, i.e. wearing the swimming top (this clause is applicable to all the educational stages).
- The above-mentioned requirements and controls are also applicable to the private schools, which don't approve specific school uniforms for the students, in terms of specifications of the shirts, skirts, swimming clothing or sports clothes.
- It is necessary to adhere to the conservative school uniform, which suits the values of the Qatari society in all the activities and occasions.
- It is necessary to adhere to the pre-issued controls regarding the intermingling between the students in the swimming classes starting from grade 4 and above.

Please find the updated DBS uniform available from our supplier Zaks attached and <u>linked below</u> for your convenience. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in adhering to these new requirements to ensure that we comply with the MoEHE directive. The appropriate swimwear can now also be purchased from Zaks.
