



Red Lanyards - compulsory requirement.

As a reminder, the school policy requires that all parents, drivers, and nannies must wear a red lanyard when onsite. ENGLISH:

<u>Preschool:</u> We will be reading 'From Head to Toe' as we explore our five senses and create our own page of the book.

Reception: We will be looking at the `Supertato' series and beginning to write some sounds and numbers in Drawing Club.

Year 1: We will be reading the book Giraffe's Can't Dance, creating illustrations and writing simple sentences in Drawing Club.

Year 2: We will be starting our new topic on autobiographies.

Year 3: We will be analysing our example text and create a stroy map for it.

Year 4: We will be creating a story map. We will be writing sentences containing adjectives and adverbs.

Year 5: We will begin to plan our narratives based on 'The Promise.'

Year 6: We will begin to plan and write our narrative based on 'Dreams of Freedom'.

MATHS:

<u>Preschool:</u> We will be using the language of size as we compare and sort objects big and small.

Reception: We will be making sets of different objects and sorting objects with different rules.

Year 1: We will be sorting objects, grouping and identifying amounts up to 10.

Year 2: We will be identifying numbers on a number line.

Year 3: We will be ordering and comparing numbers up to 1000

Year 4: We will be ordering and comparing 4 digit numbers.

Year 5: We will be exploring and comparing negative numbers, concluding our place value topic.

Year 6: We wil be adding and subtracting numbers up to 10,000,000

Year 3: We are learning to play rhythms.


Year 4: We will be using layering and timbre to rehearse our group Harry Potter ostinatos.
