## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

### 1. Device Registration

All students can register ONE personal device (laptop/tablet) for educational purposes, but it must be registered with the IT Department to allow connectivity to school networks.

For registration, students must submit the following details using the Google Form provided (see section below for campus-specific Google Form):

- Student ID
- Student Name
- Year & Group
- Device type
- Device MAC address (See guide below on how to obtain)

Once the form is submitted, the IT Department will process the details, and the student device will then have internet access.

Please Note: There is no need for the student to bring the device to the IT Dept. for registration – this will be done remotely.

### 2. School WiFi Access

- Registered devices will be configured to access the school's secure WiFi network.
- The IT Department will provide login credentials, ensuring compliance with the school's internet usage policies.
- Access to school WiFi is monitored for security and appropriate usage.
- NOTE: A device may appear to be connected to Student WiFi, but internet access will only work once the device has been registered.

### 3. Use of Personal 4G/5G Networks

- Students are requested not to share their personal phone data (mobile hotspot).
- The school cannot monitor or filter content accessed via personal data connections, increasing risks of inappropriate usage.

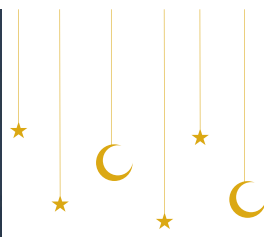

## ENGLISH



**Preschool:** We will be reading 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' as we create pictures and letters for the bears to read.

**Reception:** We will be reading the story 'Tiddler' and making lost posters to help people find Tiddler!

**Year 1:** We will be beginning to explore the story 'The Secret of Black Rock'.

**Year 2:** We will be looking at the features of a balanced argument.

**Year 3:** We will be writing a persuasive letter.

**Year 4:** We will be starting our new animation unit "Girl and Robot".

**Year 5:** We will be exploring the setting of our animation, 'Hope', gathering information to create an information leaflet on ocean pollution.

**Year 6:** We will be continuing to explore the world of Pandora through creative writing.

## MATHS

**Preschool:** We will be continuing to create and extend repeating patterns and identifying the mistake.

**Reception:** We will be reviewing 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

**Year 2:** We will be drawing our own graphics scores to match a piece of music.

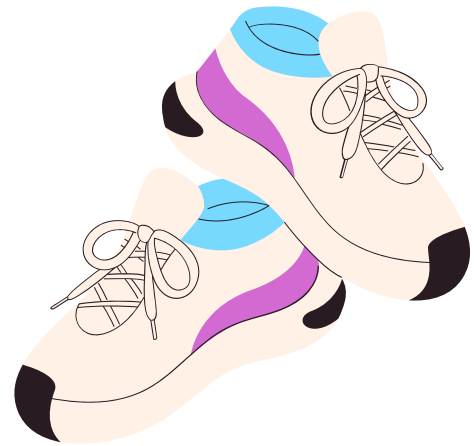
**Year 3:** We will perform our composition.

**Year 1:** A Pirate's Life for Me: A story-based, concept-driven program with skill development, light practice, and swimming for all, adapted for Ramadan.

**Year 2:** The Good Knights: Concept-driven, story-based learning with gentle skill development, social interactions, and swimming for all, following Ramadan protocols.

**Year 3:** Gymnastics & Basketball (ball Skills) with no Swimming – Adjusted for Ramadan with reduced intensity.
