ENGLISH



Preschool: We will be reading 'The Gruffalo' as we create our own terrible creatures and use describing words.

Reception: We will be reading 'Lost and Found' and writing a message in a bottle.

Year 1: We will be looking at the story of Jack and the Beanstalk and designing a trap for a Giant.

Year 2: Using the skills we have learnt so far we will be writing a diary extract based on our trip to Eataly.

Year 3: We will be starting our new book "Leon and the Place Between".

Year 4: We will be starting our new book "The Lost Happy Endings".

Year 5: This week, we will begin our new unit based on the book 'Leon and The Place Between.'

Year 6: This week, we will begin to plan our own battle narrative including our main characters, a Hero and Villain.

MATHS

Preschool: We will be measuring and comparing height.

Reception: We will be exploring subtraction using objects.

Year 1: We will start our new topic of shape, recognising 3D shapes and looking at the properties of 2D shapes.

Year 2: This week we will start our new topic on measurement, focusing on length and height.

Year 3: This week we will continue using expanded methods in multiplication.

Year 4: We will be dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers before moving onto multiplication and division word problems.

Year 5: This week, we will be continuing looking at equivalent fractions and then comparing and ordering fractions.

Year 6: This week, we will conclude our topic on ratio and begin to explore patterns in Algebra.

practicing sports vocabulary and simple structures.

Year 5: We will be working on the topic "¿Puedes
contar hasta 1000?".

Year 6: We will be working on the topic "¿Qué tipo de
persona eres?" - Gender and number agreement.

MUSIC:

EYFS: We will be learning the Moods and instruments.

Year 1: We will be learning how to write rhythms.

Year 2: We will recognise and discuss the motifs of different animals.

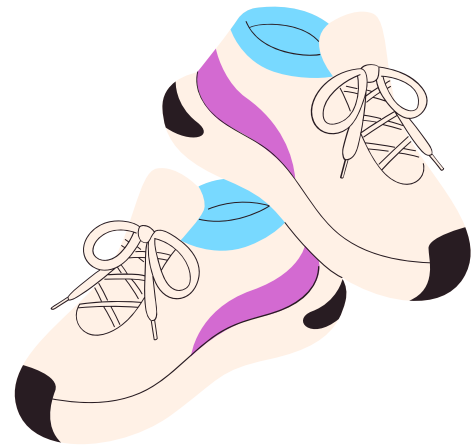
Year 3: We will create a call and response pattern.

Year 4: Popular music 20th century.

P.E:



EYFS: This term, EYFS PE will focus on movement games with friends and building skills like kindness, sharing, listening, teamwork, trust, and having fun as the focus. Reception will also start swimming focusing on building water confidence .

Year 1: Exploring movement through a story 'The Enchanted Forest' focusing on building self-esteem.(6 weeks)

Year 2: Practicing movement through Dino Island (ongoing story), focusing on fitness, balance, coordination, agility, speed, endurance, and reaction time.(6 Weeks)

Year 3 and Year 4: Year 3 will continue swimming all year round. Year 4 will have the girls swap over to take part in swimming this term.
During their PE lessons, students will begin the Striking and Fielding topic for this term, which will include games of Cricket and Rounders.(6 weeks)

Year 5: and Year 6: Years 5 and 6 will begin their Striking and Fielding topic during PE lessons this term, which will include games of Cricket and Rounders.(6 weeks)

Additionally, girls in Years 5 and 6 will take part in swimming this term.
