In Year 9...

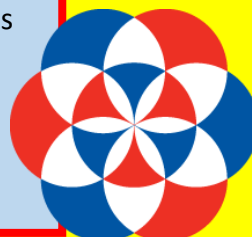
- I will explore the causes and impacts of natural disasters, along with ways to mitigate against them
