Now that we have passed the halfway point of the second half of the first term of this academic year, I would like to clarify our reporting schedule for students. The key purpose of a reporting schedule, of course, is to ensure that the three vital components of a school's community – students, parents and teachers – are all fully informed of current progress and attainment in all subjects, where current strengths and areas for improvement lie and what needs to be done next in order to guarantee that academic potential is achieved. To this end, teachers at DBS Wakra will be compiling documents which prove that they know the key headlines coming out of each class and that they are putting actions in place to ensure that all students continue to make excellent progress.

During the first week of term 2, once students have rested during their well-deserved winter break, teachers will deliver Minibites sessions as they have done previously during our last academic year. To clarify, our Minibites interventions are short, targeted lessons which will be delivered to students who teachers have identified as being in need of further learning in a particular area. For example, if a student has not yet reached their academic potential for a certain topic in Year 7 History, then they will be asked to attend a Minibites session so that any existing gaps in knowledge can be addressed. If a student is not asked to attend a session, then this simply means that they are currently assessed as not requiring additional support at this moment.
