Dear parents,

As your child approaches the end of KS4, it is normal at this time of an academic year that consideration is given to what lies ahead once IGCSE examinations have been taken in summer 2022. Currently, we are in the process of planning what our KS5 provision, also known as 6th form, will look like for DBS Wakra Year 11 students. Typically, students would begin to study either what are known as AS courses (the first year of an A-Level, or advanced level) or IB (International Baccalaureate) pathways upon commencement of this stage of their academic careers, during which studying only three subjects but in much greater detail than previously is the norm.

As our DBS Wakra cohort is very small, however, I am keen to firstly find out in more detail what our individual students would like to study so that we can put bespoke plans into place, wherever possible.
